

How to Join the ACCC

Prospective team leaders and riders:

It's easy to join & compete in the ACCCC. Here are the few simple steps:

1. In order to be considered for Nationals, you must become an official NCCA Club. The cost of NCCA team membership is \$50. Your first year is free (contact Daniel Matheny dmatheny@usacycling.org). There are TWO (2) forms required to do this:

2. Let us know you exist! Drop a line to Ruth Stornetta (conference director) [rs3j\[at\]virginia.edu](mailto:rs3j[at]virginia.edu) and let us know your website to be added to the Teams of the ACCCC page.

3. Join the ACCCC Mailing List at Topica.com. This is where all race announcements, discussion of ACCCC issues, and other interesting things happens. Go to http://www.topica.com/lists/accc_info/ and click on subscribe.

Your individual team members will need to be licensed collegiate cycling members of USA Cycling. You can do this on-line by buying a collegiate license for \$30. you will need to create an account on the USA Cycling website (<https://www.usacycling.org/myusac/index.php?pagename=login>), then go to buy/renew license, fill out your info and choose the collegiate license. If you would like to race USCF and/or NORBA as well, you can add those licenses on for an extra \$30 each.

You must be a member of a registered collegiate team in order to get a collegiate license.
