Aubrey, TX ("Horse Country USA") is a small community a few miles Northeast of Denton. The course is a 20K "out and back" on Highway 428, starting and finishing at the Aubrey Middle School. Hwy 428 is a two lane asphalt road with smooth, wide shoulders and more climbs than your average TT.

Pre-registration will end at 11:00 PM on the Thursday before the event Additional service fees apply to online registration fees

Check-in/Registration: ends 30 minutes before the first start time for each category at Hilltop Assembly of God (no cleats inside please)

- * 25 rider field max is for junior U15 and U19 combined
- ** 25rider field max is for both women's categories combined
- *** 25 rider field max is for both Masters categories combined
- **** Solo Riders start at 30 second intervals. If you miss your start, report to the start line official for instructions. 2-person teams start 1 minute apart. 4-person teams start 2 minutes apart



Rules:

- **Cash only for race day registrations and one-day licenses**
- Categories might start later than posted due to "day-of" entries, but will NOT start early.
- Promoter reserves the right to combine categories or cancel those that do not make the field minimum.
- Rider meeting 7:45- required for Junior categories
- All entrants must have current USAC annual license or buy a one-day/Annual license (\$10/\$60). Cash or credit card for Annual. NO CHECKS for any event/license.
- All USAC Time trial rules apply. Helmets must be worn when on the bike except on trainers/rollers.
- OPEN Course all traffic laws are in effect (impeding traffic, centerline, etc.).
- Ride on the shoulder only, per Aubrey PD. Plenty of room to pass without riding in the main lanes.
- All jerseys must have sleeves.
- No warm up on course after 7:45am, bring trainers or rollers please.
- No public urination or clothing changes. You might get yourself arrested, and nobody wants that.
- No alcohol consumption on school or church property.
- Mechanical support will be provided at the start/finish, SAG on course is for return to start only.
- Rain or Shine. Promoter reserves the right to cancel due to hazardous weather conditions (i.e lightning, hail), or dangerous road conditions.

Directions:

From Dallas: Take I-35E north through Denton to exit 470/Loop 288. Take Loop 288 East (right) to Hwy 428. Take 428 east about 8 miles to Hilltop Church.

From Ft. Worth: Take I-35W north through Denton to exit 470/Loop 288. Take Loop 288 East (right) to Hwy 428. Take 428 east about 8 miles to Hilltop Church.

From Plano/Frisco/McKinney via 380: Take Hwy 380 West from 75/Preston/Tollway. Turn North on Hwy 377 (marked as Pilot Point exit). Approximately 6 miles north on 377, turn left on 428/Springhill road at the light. Follow this road (becomes Main street) through downtown Aubrey. Turn left on 428 at the intersection of Main and 428. Go one mile to Hilltop Church on your left.
