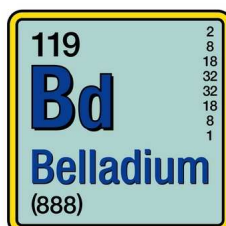

AWARDS

Must be a Tennessee resident holding an annual USAC license to qualify for state medals. One-day license holders and out-of-state riders welcome to race but not eligible for medals. Podium presentation for state championship medals awarded 90 minutes after last rider start. Master category medals awarded in 5-year increments, ie 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, etc. Junior categories awarded for age groups: 10-12, 13/14, 15/16, 17/18. State time trial champion jerseys awarded at the annual TBRA banquet with eligibility requirements the same as being awarded a medal. Only categories that are part of the TBRA Road Series will be recognized with a state TT jersey. Riders must inform officials prior to start if they wish to earn TBRA Road Series points in a category other than what they are competing for in medals, but cannot earn points in both. Payouts for Masters Men and Elite Men/Women are five deep overall in each of the three fields, not in each individual category.

RACE ROUTE

The start line will be in front of Lascassas Elementary School on Hwy 96 and will be a 100% out-and-back on Hwy 96 with no turns. The course is fairly flat and fast with a couple of rollers. There is a lot of shoulder space, and a small portion of road in Cannon County does have rumble strips along the white line. However, the shoulder space is significant. Every racer should race with their head up at all times!

The course is marked in bright orange paint. 10k, 20k and 40k markings are on right side of shoulder. The 40k turnaround is just past Kennedy Creek, which is past the convenience store in Hurricane Creek. The finish line is in front of the stone wall, near the pavilion, a few hundred meters before the start line.

REGISTRATION, PARKING & RACE DAY NUMBER PICK UP

Everyone must pre-register online at BikeReg. Registration closes on Thursday, May 26th at 11:59 AM, and no entries will be accepted after that time. There will be NO day-of registrations. Visit this link to register - <http://www.bikereg.com/events/register.asp?eventid=13368>

Race number pick up and waiver signing for the TT begin at 6:30 AM Saturday morning at Lascassas Elementary. Parking for the State TT will be at the school as well. The address is 6300 Lascassas Pike (Hwy 96), Lascassas, TN 37085. Please be respectful of school property and the surrounding community.

Every rider required to sign release waiver. One-day and annual licenses available for \$10 and \$60, respectively, but **pre-registration is required** through BikeReg.com. Entry fee includes \$3 for USAC insurance surcharge per rider and \$2 for TBRA Road Series surcharge per rider. Race number to be worn on the RIGHT SIDE of jersey.
