Coatesville Classic Bicycle Race- Omnium Criterium & Road Race

When: Sunday and Monday July 3-4, 2011!!

Where: Coatesville and surrounding area, Chester County, Pennsylvania.

What: This is an Omnium Race with prizes for both Criterium and Road Race but also overall prizes in the general classification. G.C. prizes will be based on points earned in each race. Riders can save money by entering both races for one price or enter the individual races if they can't compete on both days.

Courses: Coatesville Criterium- Sunday afternoon July 3rd. This is a fast and fun 6-corner, 1-mile per lap course in downtown Coatesville.

The Coatesville Criterium is part of the day long **Celebrate Coatesville Festival** with music, crafts, vendors and a kids' play area as well as kids' bike races. The day will finish off with the best fireworks display in Chester County! Bring the whole family.

The Brandywine Road Race on Monday morning July 4th!

A spectacularly gorgeous 11.4-mile per lap race features a fun descent followed by a beautiful run along the Brandywine River on a freshly paved road followed by a ride through famous Chester County Horse Country. The course is mostly flat with one fast climb at the end of each lap after crossing a covered bridge. This race is in the morning to beat the heat and give you enough time to enjoy the afternoon with your family.

The Coatesville Classic is part of the Road Cycling League Super Series and is sanctioned by USA Cycling. See following pages for category and general event details, registration info and course maps.

Omnium Details!

There will be **points awarded for the first 20 places in the criterium and the road race!** 1st=27 points, 2nd=24 points, 3rd=21 points 4th is 19 points, 5th is 17, 6th is 15 and one point less for each place down to 1 point for finishing 20th. The rider with most points wins the Omnium. In the event of a tie on G.C. points, the rider with better placing on the final race, (Brandwine River Road Race) will be awarded the higher place.

This omnium is part of the **Road Cycling League Super Series**. Points will be based on the final G.C. of the Omnium. Here are the categories that are part of the Super Series: Pro/1/2 Men, 3/4 Men, 1/2/3 Women, 40+ Men and 50+ Men. Full details can be downloaded at www.roadcyclingleague.com

Road Course Note: Use caution when checking out the road course in advance.

The covered bridge has some large gaps that can catch a wheel. We will cover those gaps on race day.



Pre-register here:



Pre-Reg. closes Thursday June 30 at 8 p.m. (Service fees will apply for online registration). There will be a day of registration if there is still room in your category. This is a USA Cycling event. All riders must have a current USAC license to race. Beginners- (Cat. 5 men or Cat. 4 Women) may purchase a one day license at registration if they don't have an annual license. There is a \$5 late fee for day of registration.

Parking for racers is inside the course at the corner of Harmony St. and 3rd St. Coatesville PA, 19320 Port-o-pots will be there too. Registration - Start and Finish for the Coatesville Criterium are all at 1st Ave. and Harmony St.

From Rt. 30, take Rt. 82 south two miles into Coatesville and turn left onto E. Diamond St. (It looks like an alley). Go two blocks and turn right on third.

Explain to marshal you are in the race and they will direct you across course to parking lot.

The course is 30 miles from Lancaster City, 25 Miles from West Chester PA, 42 miles from York PA, 45 miles from Philadelphia, 27 miles from Wilmington DE, 56 miles from Allentown PA, 74 miles from Baltimore and 127 miles from NYC, about 2 hours and 20 minutes, by car. Kid's Races: Sunday July 3rd at 2:45 p.m. Distances for ages 3-4, 5-6 300 feet, followed by ages 7 to 8, then 9-10 600 feet and ages 11 -14, 1 lap.

All children must have a parent's signature for the release. Register day of the event. Free! Registration tent will be next to the Start/finish line tent in at corner of Harmony St. and 1st Ave. between Noon and 2:30 p.m. to pick up your race packet and instructions. Training wheels are okay, No tricycles except in the 3 to 4 year old category.

Your bicycle must be in good condition and you must have a properly fitting helmet.
