

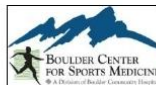
# 2011 BOULDER CUP

# PART 1: Rules and Regulations

## 1.1 Regulations:

This is a UCI Class 1 event, held under UCI regulations and USAC Permit. The UCI scale of penalties shall apply.

## 1.2 Participation:

### 1.2.1 Categories:

- 1) The UCI C1 events are open to UCI Elite Men (U23 riders age 19-22 may also ride in the Elite Men's race, and Elite Women (Junior Women age 17-18 may also ride in the Elite Women's race).
- 2) A UCI or USAC International license is required to participate in the Elite Men and Women categories.
- 3) No rider under the age of 17 may compete in a UCI category race (Elite Men & Elite Women). Junior Men with a cyclocross racing age of 17 or 18 may not ride in the UCI Elite Men/U23 Men race.
- 4) Racing age: A rider's racing age is determined by 2012 minus the riders year of birth

### Registration:

- 1) Pre-registration is available through [www.dbcevents.com](http://www.dbcevents.com). Online registration closes 12pm MST Friday October 28, 2011.
- 2) Number pick up Friday 5pm - 8:30pm DBC Events 1722 14<sup>th</sup> Boulder or all day at the Colorado Cross Classic Saturday October 29<sup>th</sup> at Boulder Reservoir
- 3) Day-of-race registration is available if it has not sold out. Race day Registration closes 30 minutes before start time. Registration fee increases \$10

### 1.2.3. Schedule and Fees:

- 1) Registration Fee: \$45
- 2) Staging/Call-ups: 10 minutes before start of your race and based on UCI Standings
- 3) Race Start times: see table listing below.
- 4) Duration: see category listing below.
- 5) Awards Top 3, immediately after finish (5 minutes after winner is announced)

## 1.3 Race Headquarters & Press Room:

Race Headquarters & Press Room will be located at Historic Farm House Bldg

## 1.4 Anti-Doping:

All races are conducted under USA Cycling, UCI and USADA anti-doping regulations. Riders must check to see if they are required to submit to doping control. Doping Control will be located beside the awards podium at the finish line

## **1.5 First-Aid/EMT's:**

Located at the Start/Finish area. The nearest hospital is located 1 mile away Boulder Community Foothills Hospital 4747 Arapahoe Avenue (Arapahoe & Foothills Parkway) Boulder, CO 80303 (720) 854-7000

## **1.6 Number Placement:**

Hip numbers are to be placed on your right side. Shoulder numbers shall be worn on the upper forearm/shoulder so it is visible frontally. Riders shall ensure that their number is visible and legible at all times. Numbers folded, altered or not well fixed will result in a fine according to USAC & UCI regulations.

## **1.8 Start Order & Staging Protocol:**

UCI rule 5.1.043 – Elite/U23: The start order will be determined by the order of latest published UCI cyclocross point classification from highest to lowest, as posted on the UCI website [www.uci.ch](http://www.uci.ch). Riders with 0 UCI points will be determined by random order. The start order will correspond with each rider's start/bib number. They will be called up to the line with this bib number.

## **1.9 Lapped Riders in UCI Events (UCI Rule 5.1.051):**

Lapped riders must complete the lap during which they were lapped and leave the event via an exit located before the finishing strait or in the "80%" zone as described in article 5.1.052, if that rule applies. They will be listed in the results in the order from which they were pulled out of the race plus the number of laps that have not been completed

## **1.9.2 Unauthorized Refreshments (UCI Rule 5.1.038)**

In the event of warm weather conditions, (above 20 C ) the commissaries' panel may decide to allow feeding in the pit lane. Under those conditions, feeding is not allowed during the first 2 laps and last 2 laps of the race. Accepting hand ups from spectators –including bottles, cans, or money is not permitted and will result in disqualification.

1.9.3 No Alcohol is not permitted on the race course or in the technical area

1.9.4 Pit and Bike Washing Area : behind the Historic Farm House near the pit

1.9.5 Pit Pass & Mechanic's Protocol:

a) Mechanical Passes will be issued at Registration/Package Pick up. Each rider has a right to only one assistant per pit area. No other personnel will be allowed in the pit zone.

b) Elite riders will be assigned designated pit box areas for mechanics and for bike changes will take place. Pit Boxes will be assigned by random lot on Sunday Oct 30 by 10am. Bike changes may only take place in the pit areas

## **1.10 Prizes**

### **1.10.1. Awards Area:**

Riders finishing in the top 3 shall report IMMEDIATELY to the podium waiting area. Only riders and staff are allowed in the podium waiting area. NO EXCEPTIONS. Mechanics must post bikes in the "winner's rack" within 5 minutes of the finish. Riders shall arrive at the podium waiting area attired in team racing attire or team casual wear only. No street clothing is permitted in the Award Ceremony

a) **2 sets of Stairs, 1 sandpit**

b) **varied terrain:** 2% Sand; 5% Pavement; 8% Grass; 79% Hard packed dirt

### 2.3 Warm-ups:

Course will only be open for warm ups during designated times

**NOTE:** Warming up on the course while a race is in progress is strictly prohibited.
