

## NORTHERN CALIFORNIA & NEVADA TIME TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Hosted by Reno Wheelmen and Held under USA Cycling event permit

Championship event for all classes EXCEPT Juniors – their championship is Dunlap TT  
**PRE-REGISTRATION ONLY - NO RACE DAY ENTRIES**

**SUNDAY, JUNE 10, 2012.** Sattley, California. 30 miles north of Truckee, CA on State Highway 89.

**COURSE:** Flat, surveyed, out and back course, for both 20K and 40K. 10K course is NOT surveyed. Elevation 4,900 ft. Start and finish on Westside Road (A17), 0.5 mi. northeast of Sattley.

**ENTRIES – PRE-REG. ONLY: MUST BE RECEIVED BY NOON FRIDAY JUNE 8, 2012.**

**SPECIFY THE CLASS/CATEGORY ENTERED:** All riders please select the appropriate category during registration. Be sure to enter the category appropriate for your race age for those categories that specify an age range. Riders may register in more than one category, however, the racer is responsible for being able to make both start times.

**AVAILABLE CLASSES AND APPROXIMATE START ORDER:** Race distances are listed on the registration site. 10K events start at 8:00 am. Followed immediately by 20k events. All other start times are approximate as listed below.  
Elite: 8:30, Masters Men 30 and up: 9:00, Handcycling: 9:30, Masters Women 30 and up: 9:40, Cat 4/5 events: 9:50, Tandems: 10:00.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all riders, but only riders (per annual license) who are permanent residents or US citizens, who reside in California/Nevada and are not UCI Men's Trade Team I or II members are eligible to win USCF medals in championship events. Separate medals are awarded for top finishers in non-championship categories

**CHECK-IN:** All riders must check in. Check-in opens at 6:30 a.m. YOU MUST BRING A CURRENT LICENSE OR COPY OF AUTHORIZATION TO RIDE FROM USACYCLING. ALSO PLEASE FILL OUT AND BRING RACE RELEASE FORM.

**START TIME:** We will not be mailing start times. Start times will be e-mailed to all registered participants and posted on the web site at [www.renowheelmen.org](http://www.renowheelmen.org) If you cannot find your start time, please contact the race organizer on Friday, June 10 at (775) 750-0157. First rider goes off at 8:00 and every 30 or 60 seconds thereafter. Start order is Junior men, junior Women, Masters 65+, Master Women 55+, Elite, Under 23, Elite Women, Under 23 Women, Masters, Master Women, non-championship 40 K events, Tandems.

**DISTANCE:** Juniors 14 and younger: 10 km; Juniors 15 and older, Masters 65+, and Master Women 55+: 20 km; all others: 40 km.

**CLASSES/CATEGORIES:** Fields in accordance with USCF Championship guidelines (see current USCF rulebook) plus Masters Men Cat 4/5, Masters Women Cat 4/5, and Handcycling 20k and 40k open category.

**PRIZES:** Medals for top three riders each event. Plaques presented to the fastest male and female in the 20K and 40 K.

**LODGING:** Numerous motels available in Truckee, CA (30 mi.), Loyalton, CA (12 mi.), Portola, CA (12 mi.) and Reno, NV (45 mi.).
