Start/Finish at Live Oak Park, Manhattan Beach. Race runs north up Valley to Pacific, and south down Ardmore to 15th. All USAC rules apply. Second race is \$15, after paying for highest race first. JUNIORS may race in their respective Elite category. USAC free lap rule is in effect. NEUTRAL PIT provided by SRAM (NO WHEELS ALLOWED). Registration desk opens day of race at 6:00am for Cat 4s and 6:45am for all other races, and closes 15 minutes before individual race start time. NO CREDIT CARDS accepted at race. Postmarked pre-entry closes June 20th. socialreg.com online registration closes on June 23rd at 10:00pm. Late entry fee is \$10.00. Surcharges are applied to online registration. One-day licenses available ONLY for 55/60+ race. Make checks payable to MBGP. Mail checks and standard 2012 USAC release form to: Manhattan Beach Grand Prix, 2711 N. Sepulveda Blvd #528, Manhattan Beach, CA 90266.

Registration/numbers also available 2-5 PM Saturday, July 7, 2012 at baseball field south of S/F (Valley Drive) – NO LATE FEE.

DIRECTIONS: From 405 N or S, exit Inglewood Blvd and go south one block. Right (west) on Manhattan Beach Blvd. Proceed 2.7 miles into downtown Manhattan Beach. Parking is available at various city lots and parking meters . ALL DOWNTOWN PARKING IS METERED. Many 3-hour and several 10-hour lots available. Turn 3-4 and staging is one block north of Manhattan Beach Blvd on Valley/Ardmore and 15th.
