Registration and staging take place at [Fulton Jr. High](#), 307 Kyle Rd, O'Fallon, IL.

Race day registration opens at 7:00 am and closes 30 minutes prior to each event. There is a \$5 surcharge for race day registration.

All races are part of MOBAR competition.

Kids' races are free to enter but each child must register and wear an approved helmet.

General Rules

All 2012 USAC rules are in effect.

A current USAC license must be presented at registration. One-day and annual Licenses will be available for purchase on site.

Events will be held rain or shine.

Helmets must be worn on the bike at all times.

All numbers supplied by the promoter must be used. No folding or cutting of numbers is allowed. See example at registration for specific placement.

Junior riders must use gearing as per USAC regulations.

The yellow line rule will be strictly enforced.

A feed zone will be located along Kyle Road.

Corner marshals will be on the course, but ultimately, it is the riders' responsibility to know the course!

Wheel vehicles are provided (wheels in, wheels out). Wheels can be picked up at the finish area after the race.

Eligibility for Illinois Championship A valid annual USAC license, Illinois resident and US citizen or permanent resident. State championship jerseys are awarded to the first Illinois rider meeting the state championship eligibility requirements where the champion has beaten at least one other rider.
