Packet Pickup: Rider's will pick up Omnium race registration packet on Friday July 12 at Mastropietro's Winery from 2:00-5:00 p.m. at TT registration site. This packet will include numbers, pins, TT start time, race manual, maps and community information.

Start Time: First rider will take off at 5:00 pm. Each rider after that will leave in: 30sec intervals. Please line up in the order you are assigned, 3 minutes prior to start time. You will be called to the line 15-:30sec prior to your start. It is the rider's responsibility to be on time and ready to start.

Start/Finish: Riders will stage facing east on Ellsworth Rd at the corner of Ellsworth Rd and Weaver Road in front of the winery. Riders must stay inside the staging cones. No warming up on the course once racing begins. Riders must warm up on Newton Falls Road: Turn right out of the winery and go 1/4 mile and the first right is Newton Falls Road.

Course Description: Embrace the ambiance of Italy as you set your wheels on the grounds of Mastropietro's Winery. This orchard is set amidst a one-acre lake with indoor/outdoor wining and dining for the start of an exciting weekend of racing. This flat to rolling 8.5 mile prologue type course will set the stage for 3 days of intense racing. This course is an out and back route on quiet country roads leading back to the scenic

outdoors of the winery. The awards presentation for all categories will be presented onsite at the winery immediately following. Enjoy dinner and a glass of wine at Mastropietro's during the ceremony!

REGISTRATION: Registration and packet pick up will be provided onsite.

AWARDS: TT awards will be issued at Mastropietro's Winery on Friday after all time trial participants have competed.

Course Description: The YSU course is a 1 mile criterium through historical downtown Youngstown and YSU campus. It consists of 4 turns around the downtown Youngstown Ohio.

Directions: From the North: Follow Rt 80 to Rt 680 S. From 680 S follow to exit 6B Market St/Youngstown and turn Right. Follow to the center of town. From the South: Follow Rt 680 N to Rt 62/Hubbard exit 6. Follow to Rt 422 W exit and continue to the Wick Ave/YSU exit. Make a left onto Wick Ave and continue to course at center of town.

About:

Tour of the Valley is a carbon-neutral, competitive, multi-stage event with 400+ pro and elite amateur riders from across the Midwest, Mid-Atlantic and beyond, touring the Mahoning and Columbiana Counties via 21 races in July. Competing for cash prizes.

Course Description: Held on downtown Luray streets with a “Taste of Luray” festival provided by the Luray Downtown Initiative, this Critérium is not your typical office-park crit! The course is a 0.8 mile loop featuring eight 90-degree turns and a steep short climb to the finish line. It’s a technical course that will not necessarily favor the sprinters alone!
