Just as feeder forces you back onto 183 North you'll turn right onto a tiny road. Road is called Smith (street sign is usually missing). Right onto Smith. Immediate left, road parallels HWY 183 North. Follow road as it bends around to the right and goes into a wooded area. Left onto Delwau, cross bridge, cross railroad tracks. Drive slow please as there are residents with small children and dogs along Delwau. Delwau dead-ends into the Driveway.
