Course Description:

The course has a good amount of elevation change with a run up, a set of barriers and a switchback climb. A dual sided bit will be about half way through the course. Spectators can view almost the entire course from atop the hill making it a great place to watch the race unfold.

Registration:

Pre-registration will be open on bikereg.com until October 18th at 6:00pm. There is a \$10 late fee for day-of registration.

Day of Registration and sign-in will be open at 7:30AM and will close 30 min prior to each race.

A USAC license is required to participate in this race, day-of and annual licenses will be available for purchase at registration.

Amenities:

Registration will at the top of the hill.

We will have a hose located by the barn.

We will have some sort of food and beverage vendor on site(posted soon).

Call-up Protocol:

Call-ups will only be awarded by promoter discretion. We will try to utilize the series standings and registration order

Staging will begin 10 minutes prior to each race

Lapped Riders:

Lapped riders will finish on the same lap as the leaders. Riders in danger of being lapped must yield to oncoming racers and are not to interfere with their progress or trail behind

Note:

The course will be open for inspection and warm-up at approximately 7:30am.

Every racer must have an approved helmet.

Mountain bikes will be allowed WITHOUT bar ends.
