



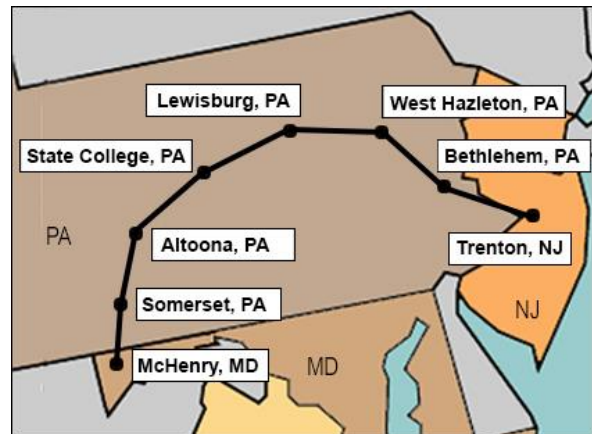
Help the Kids!

- ❖ School-based counseling, and
- ❖ Teen and parent support groups, community education and awareness programs
- ❖ Connecting Youth Program helps youth ages 14-17 build a support system so they have life-long connections within the community
