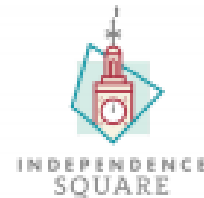

Points:

Points will be awarded to the top ten finishers in each category per race, scoring only those who qualify for the Omnium. The points will be awarded equally for all three events (time trial, circuit race, criterium), from 10 points for 1st place descending to 1 point for 10th place. In order to qualify for the Omnium, each racer must "start" all three events. If a racer does not qualify for the Omnium, their results are omitted from the Omnium scoring. Ties will be broken as follows: 1. Total points, descending; 2. Number of First place finishes, descending; 3. Number of Second Place finishes, descending; 4. Number of Third Place finishes, descending; and 5. Highest points earned in last race, descending.

Important Note: The Time Trial and Omnium are only available through online registration, which ends on Wednesday, July 19th. Each rider will be notified in advance of his or her specific TT start time.

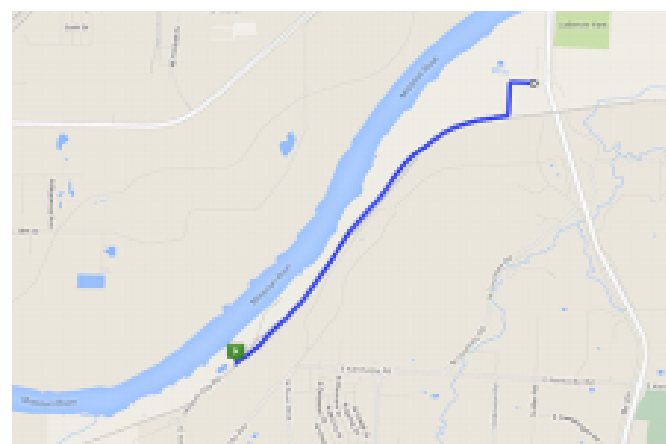
Course: Out and back course totaling 5.6 miles on Cement City Road in Sugar Creek, Missouri. The road is completely flat with two 90 degree turns each way and a 180 degree turn-around at the halfway point just before MO 291 Highway. The road will be closed to traffic, allowing racers full use of the right lane. Aero equipment (bars, wheels, helmets, frames, etc.) is permissible, but not required, on this fast course. Parking is located at Mike Onka Hall - 11520 E. Putnam Road Sugar Creek, MO. This is also where racers will receive their bib numbers.

Note: Riders will be sent from the Start Line at 30 second intervals. There will be no warming up allowed on the course once racers start going off at 6:00. You may use the local roads or bring a trainer for warm-ups. The start/finish is located just east of the second set of railroad tracks on Cement City Road, so please allow yourself enough time to get there in case a train arrives, blocking access to the start.

Directions:

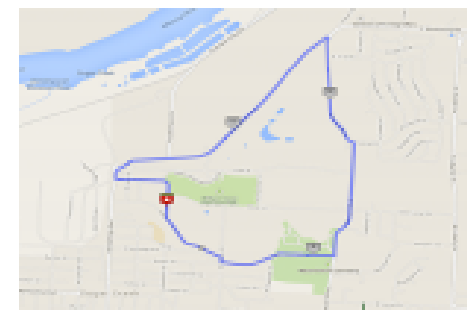
From I-70: Exit on Sterling Rd in Independence and Travel North 4.5 miles. Turn Right on Putnam. Mike Onka Hall parking lot is straight ahead at 11520 E. Putnam Road Sugar Creek, MO.

From 435: Exit on 24 Hwy and travel East for 2.4 miles. Head North on Sterling Rd for another mile. Turn Right on Putnam. Mike Onka Hall parking lot is straight ahead at 11520 E. Putnam Road Sugar Creek, MO.

^ Category 3 Women will be scored separately for MOBAR, but will remain combined for the prize payout.

The Women Masters race will be scored separately for KBAR (40+, 50+, 60+) but will remain combined for prize payout.

Registration: Registration opens at 7:30 AM and closes 30 minutes prior to the start of each race. Day of race registration will incur an additional \$5 Fee. Registration is located in Mike Onka Hall near the start/finish line. You must have your current USAC license. Riders may enter a second race for \$10. One-Day licenses will be available for beginner riders and are not available to riders who have previously upgraded beyond beginner categories. A one-day license is \$10.00 and is available at registration. Online registration is available until Wednesday, July 19, 2017 at <http://www.usacycling.org>. KCA, MOBRA, and USACycling rider insurance fees are included in the entry fee, but on-line registration fees will have a small additional charge. Junior Entry fees are sponsored by the Keen Wealth Advisors and the KCA.

Course: 3.9 Mile circuit race around the hills of Sugar Creek. Starting North on Vermont street the course will head around a left bend onto Putnam Street. Hard right turn will take you onto Sterling Ave then another slight right to start the 1 mile climb on Kentucky Ave. Right on River Blvd will take you south until a right onto Mallison Rd will take you down a long Descent until you reach an "S" curve with a right on Forest St and a quick left onto Wayne City Rd. A final right bend will bring you back to Vermont with a short hill to the finish line. The course does include some open roads, so all participants need to be on the lookout for traffic.

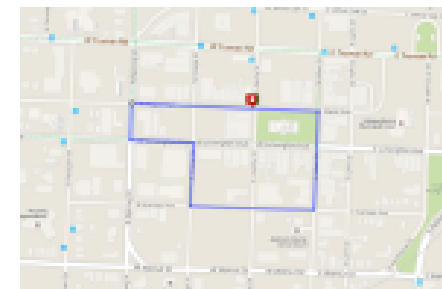
Directions:

From 435, Exit on 24 Hwy and travel East for 2.4 miles. Head North on Sterling Rd for another mile. Parking for the race is at the empty lot at corner of Sterling Rd and Elizabeth st. **Registration is located in Mike Onka Hall near the start/finish line, 11520 E. Putnam St, Sugar Creek, MO**

[^] Kansas State Age Group Championship and 2x KBAR points. State Championship medals are awarded for Masters in 5 year age groups and for Juniors in 2 year age groups. You must be a Kansas resident with an annual USAC license to qualify.

[@] Category 5 men are not eligible for Category 4 KBAR, MOBAR or Omnium points.

[%] The Women's Category 3/4/5 Race will be used for Category 3 MOBAR and Category 4 KBAR and Category 4 Omnium points.

[#] The Masters Women Race will be scored separately for KBAR and Kansas State Age Group Championship, but will be combined for prize payout.

[!] The Masters Men 60+, 65+ will be scored separately for KBAR and Kansas State Age Group Championship, but will be combined for prize payout.

[~] The Category 3/4 Men will be used for Category 3 KBAR, MOBAR and Omnium points.

Registration: Registration opens at 7:30 AM and closes 30 minutes prior to the start of each race. Day of race registration will incur an additional \$5 Fee. Registration is located in front of the Courthouse near the start/finish line. You must have your current USAC license. Riders may enter a second race for \$10. One-Day licenses will be available for beginner riders and are not available to riders who have previously upgraded beyond beginner categories. A one-day license is \$10.00 and is available at registration. Online registration is available until Wednesday, July 19, 2017 at <http://www.usacycling.org>. KCA, MOBRA, and USACycling rider insurance fees are included in the entry fee, but on-line registration fees will have a small additional charge. Junior Entry fees are sponsored by the Keen Wealth Advisors and the KCA.

Course: Six corner .7 mile course around the Independence downtown square and lined by local restaurants and businesses. The race will start and finish near the historic Jackson County Courthouse and will feature a slight uphill rise to the finish line. The course is outlined by Maple to the north (Start/Finish); Main to the east; Kansas to the south; and Spring to the West.

Directions: From I-70, exit on Noland Road in Independence and travel north 3 miles to Walnut Street and turn left. The Independence Square is on your right after you cross the railroad tracks, however, you are encouraged to park in the large parking lot on the corner of Walnut and Osage. Overflow parking is located at the corner of N Memorial Drive and E Truman road as well as the corner of E Lexington and N Lynn St. Registration and the start/finish line is north 2 blocks to Maple and east 1 1/2 blocks near Main. The address for the Courthouse is 111 W. Lexington Ave, Independence, MO 64050.

Rules: All USAC rules apply. You must wear a CPSC approved helmet at all times. Promoter and officials reserve the right to adjust race times and combine classes. Junior Gear Development Rules apply. Riders under 18 must have rider release signed by parent or guardian. Races will be held rain or shine.

Note: The Truman Cup is part of the 2017 KCA KBAR/KBAT and MOBR BARR Series. Individual and team points will be awarded towards the KBAR/KBAT & Keen Wealth Cup Championships per the 2017 KCA KBAR/KBAT rules. 2016 KBAR and MOBAR Winners receive one free entry in these races. Please contact the race promoter for the "Free Entry" code.
