### Fees:

- \$35 pre-registration on line at USA Cycling
- \$40 day of registration
- \$20 for Juniors
- \$20 for **Beginners**
- **No Refunds**
- **NO ADDITIONAL FEE FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION.**
- **Fees include insurance surcharge of \$3.75/day. Riders without USAC Road licenses purchase 1-day licenses at \$10 additional and race Masters, Cat 5 (or Junior -18 or Women Cat 4) or Beginner class. Duration times approximate.**

### Registration Online at [USA Cycling](#):

- **Race day registration** and number pick-up will take place at Centennial Plaza, 200 E. Beach Blvd. Gulfport, MS 39507. You should enter the facility at the east gate off of 2nd Street. See directions below.
- **Opens at 7:30 am and Closes 30 minutes** prior to each race for that category.
- Racers (including children 10 and over) must have a valid USAC Road license or 1-day license to be eligible for ANY Race.
- \$10 one day licenses are available for all races on line at [USA Cycling](#) and on Race day at registration
- Fees include insurance surcharge of \$3.75/day. Non-USAC riders purchase 1-day licenses at \$10 additional and race Masters, Cat. 5, Junior-18 or Women Cat. 5. Distances/times approximate.  
\*\*75-rider field limit in Cat. 5 races.

**Equipment:** All USAC Rules Apply - Jerseys must have sleeves - Approved Helmets must be worn - Numbers must be placed on the left side. - Number CAN NOT be folded. - Audio players, i.e. mp3 players, are NOT allowed.

**Helmets:** Per USA Cycling rule 1J1, Riders are required to wear a securely fastened helmet at all times while mounted on a bicycle.

**Primes:** All races will have cash and/or prize primes to be determined by the promotor.



**Course:** The course this year is located in historic Centennial Plaza east of downtown Gulfport. The .8 mile course will be completely closed to traffic. Road surfaces will be well swept, but the pavement is older and can be rough in spots.



**Directions:** We will be using the East gate to enter Centennial Plaza. This gate is located near 205 2nd St, Gulfport, MS 39507. Coming from the east Follow I-12 E and I-10 E to exit 34A. Take US 49 S. In 2.7 miles turn left onto 34th street. In 1.9 miles turn right onto Hewes Ave. After 1 mile turn left onto 2nd Street. Continue on 2nd to the entrance gate. Alternately, if coming from East Beach Blvd, turn north on Hewes Ave and then turn right on 2nd Street. Continue on 2nd Street to the entrance gate.

## Race Information & Rules

1. Riders are not permitted to warm up on the course until all riders from the previous race have finished. Please listen to the officials in regards to when the course is open.
2. The free lap rule will be in effect. You must report to the pit in order to receive a free lap. The pit will be located near the start line. Riders suffering a mishap may not ride against traffic in order to get to the pit. Proceed in the direction of the race only. **FREE LAPS WILL BE GRANTED ONLY TO RIDERS WHO RE-ENTER THE RACE BEFORE THE FINAL 4 LAPS.**
3. All riders finish on the same lap as the leader. Lapped riders will be pulled if threatening to interfere with the finish.
4. Lapped riders may not compete for primes. Lapped riders who compete for primes or bonus points will be disqualified! Riders may not drop back in order to assist another rider off the front of the pack.
5. Following a bunch sprint, riders in the group must verify their presence in the group with the judges immediately after the sprint.
6. All USA Cycling rules will be enforced at all times.

### RACE NUMBER PLACEMENT:

### LEFT SIDE



The race number should be placed on the side of the lower back, just above the pockets (if any), turned so that the numbers are upright when the rider is horizontal.

Numbers go on the **LEFT SIDE!**
