Registration will be held the day of the race beginning at **8:00am** at Elk City Lake, Elk City, Oklahoma. On-site registration will end 30 minutes prior to start time! Helmets are required when rider is on the bike. **On-line race fees:** Jrs \$20, Cat 3 \$25, Cat 1 & 2 \$30. \$5 late fee for race-day registration (no late fee for Juniors). **To avoid waiting in line on race day online registration is highly recommended** and available at www.usacycling.org. Racers (except Jrs) may sign electronically the standard release – you must log onto your USA Cycling account – if you do not have one you may create one for no charge at www.usacycling.org

Cat 1 riders must have an annual USAC MTB \$70 license, available online, or on site. One-day licenses for **Cat 2 & 3** riders can be purchased for \$10 at the race. **To qualify for Tour de Dirt (TdD) Series awards** all Cat 1 & Cat 2 racers must have an annual USAC MTB license. See www.usacycling.org. **Cat 3** racers are eligible for TdD Series awards using one-day licenses.

A \$5 TdD number plate is required to participate in any TdD event in 2017. These number plates are available at any TdD event registration. **Racers must show their 2017 TdD # plate before they will be allowed to register for the Okie Spokie Classic.** For additional rules & regulations for the TdD see www.oktdd.org. All Cat 1 / Pro Women & Cat 1 50+ men will race the Cat 2 distance. Cat 1 Jrs race the Cat 2 distance. Cat 1 will race approx 30 miles, Cat 2 approx 20 miles, and Cat 3 approx 10 miles. The promoter reserves the right to adjust start times, mileage, and cancel/combine events.

Directions Exit I-40 and go south 8/10s of a mile and turn west on Lakeview Rd, then travel 1/2 mile and turn south onto Washington, drive 7/10s of a mile and turn west into Elk City Lake Park
