2010 USA Cycling Mountain Bike State & Regional Championship Program

Purpose

The purpose of the USA Cycling Mountain Bike State and Regional Championship (USAC-MTB) is to recognize the best mountain bike racers in each state and region. Through the USA Cycling MTB State and Regional Championships, riders will be eligible for state and regional titles and medals, along with being able to qualify and compete at the USA Cycling MTB National Championships.

USAC-MTB State and Regional Championships/Recognized Disciplines

The 2010 USA Cycling MTB State and Regional Championship recognized disciplines will follow what is recognized for Mountain Bike National Championships.

USAC-MTB National Championships

The 2010 USAC-MTB Mountain Bike State and Regional Championships will serve as qualifiers for the USA Cycling MTB National Championships to be held July 15-18, 2010 in Granby, Colorado.

The top-15 riders from each discipline, category, and age-group offered at the USAC-MTB National Championships and the USAC-MTB State and Regional Championships (same discipline and category) and will be eligible to compete at the USAC-MTB National Championships. Riders will also need to be United States citizen or permanent resident (amateur categories only) and have a current annual USA Cycling MTB license. Specific qualification procedures and guidelines will be posted to www.usacycling.org.

Promoter Eligibility Requirements

Organizations, clubs or promoters applying for a USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship designation must have a demonstrated ability to organize high quality, professional events. Applicants must meet the following guidelines:

- Organized at least three successful mountain bike events in the last three years. Preference will be given to established USAC-MTB promoters, clubs, and organizations.
- The host organization must be or join as a USA Cycling club or event organizer.
- The USA Cycling club or event organizer must be in good financial standing with USA Cycling.
- First year promoters are generally not eligible to promote a USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship, but consideration will be given to promoters who have organized other athletic events.

Rider Eligibility Requirements

- Riders must be an annual USAC-MTB licensee in order to be eligible for State/Regional Championship medals and titles

Results and Rankings

Events organizers hosting a USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship must submit race results to USA Cycling within 24-hours of each event in the series or one-day event. All USAC-MTB State and Regional Championships are required to submit race results in the USA Cycling rankings categories and age-groups.

2010 USAC-MTB State & Regional Championship Program

Championship Format

An official USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship follows one of two formats: **Series** or **Event**. Regardless of the format chosen, it must be clearly and openly stated in this application and in the official event announcement.

Series: A USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship Series includes two or more events in which riders may accumulate points in the designated discipline stated on the application toward an overall total for the series. The highest ranking rider in each discipline and class and category determines the USAC-MTB State or Regional Champion. **A series format is generally preferred for USAC-MTB State and Regional Championships.**

One-Day Event: The USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship Event format may be a single event held on one day or weekend to determine the USAC-MTB State or Regional Champion in the designated discipline stated on the application.

Category and Age-Group Requirements

Event organizers hosting a USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship are strongly encouraged to provide the minimum class and category requirements outlined in this application. USAC-MTB will only provide medals for Championship disciplines, categories, and age-groups. Promoters who offer non-Championship categories, disciplines, or age-groups will be responsible for providing medals for these classes.

Event organizers may use five-year age groups within the 10-year age break format if they wish to do so. Riders who qualify for the USAC-MTB National Championships may qualify in their respective 10-year age group at a USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship, but they will compete in their age group as of their racing age on December 31 of the current year. Organizers may also run the current MTB National Championship categories and age-groups, as outlined in the 2010 USA Cycling Rulebook.

Application Period

Completed application for a 2010 USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship will be accepted between January 5, 2010 and April 15, 2010. Championship titles will start to be awarded on January 5, 2010. Early submission of applications is highly encouraged. USAC-MTB State and Regional Championships are not awarded on a multi-year basis. Successful applicants will be notified via email or postal mail.

- Please complete the application as thoroughly as possible. Be specific and accurate in your responses. Items in this application may be used in press releases and/or posted to www.usacycling.org.
- Additional materials and documentation describing the series or event may be included to enhance the application.
- If multiple event organizers are participating in the proposed USAC-MTB State or Regional Championship, one must be designated as the primary coordinator and contact for the series.
