

*2010 NRC Evaluation Criteria  
for 2009 NRC Races*

- 1. Course management/control: Any reports regarding course security and/or conditions*
- 2. Financial: Confirm that minimum prize list, officials and all post event fees are paid in full and on time.*
- 3. Results: Uploaded to the USA Cycling website according to the format guidelines and established deadlines.*
- 4. USA Cycling Branding: Confirm current and correct logo use on website, finish line and all collateral material per NRC guidelines.*
- 5. The race meets all Category A requirements. Please see rule 3A9, pg 94 2009 USA Cycling rulebook*
- 6. Spectator attendance reports by law enforcement agencies*
- 7. Chief Referee report/review*
- 8. Team evaluation*
- 9. Media coverage summary*
- 10. Medical services plan*
- 11. Schedule: Was NRC race run at the time posted on the race schedule?*
- 12. Calendar flow: How does the event fit into the overall calendar (USAC Pro Tour and NRC) schedule for team travel?*

*How the selection process works:*

- 1. If there are no reports, events will receive 5 points. One point removed per mentioned item.*
- 2. Five points for total documentation. One point removed per missing item*
- 3. Five points for uploading per requirements. One point removed per day.*
- 4. Five points for full compliance. Deduct one point for each for website, finish line, tech guide, collateral material.*
- 5. 5 points for full compliance, deduct one point per discrepancy*
- 6. One point for <2.5k, 2 pts for 2.5k-4.5k, 3 pts for 4.5k-6.5k, 4 pts for 6.5k-9k, 5 pts for >9k.*
- 7. One point deduction for each no checked, except for "Event Conduct", where a yes will have a 1 point deduction*
- 8. One point deduction for each negative comment.*
- 9. One point: local media, 2 pts: local TV, 3 pts: regional/state coverage, 4 pts: National media, 5 pts: national TV*
- 10. Medical services will be evaluated on the type of race, i.e. stage race, criterium, etc*
- 11. Deduct 1 point for every 15 minutes late for the NRC portions only.*
- 12. This will be determined by the applications received.*
