Course Description

Course is a classic flat four corner, .80 mile, rectangle criterium course. Start-Finish is located beside Pullman Square entertainment complex, running between 8th & 10th streets on 3rd & 4th avenues.

Details

All USA Cycling rules apply. Free-lap rule is in effect. Lapped riders may be pulled at the Officials' discretion. You must present a valid 2012 USA Cycling license at registration to enter any race. Only Category 5 men and Category 4 women who do not have a valid racing license may purchase a one-day license for \$10.00 at registration. First-time women racers race for free. Promoters reserve the right to shorten, modify, cancel, or combine any race or prize list in the event of insufficient entries or bad weather. Day of race registration opens at 1:00 p.m. and closes 30 minutes before the start of each race. \$10.00 fee for each additional race. There must be twice as many racers as there are places paid. Helmets are required.
