**Registration:** Opens March 18 on [www.usacycling.org](http://www.usacycling.org)

**Pre-reg** pricing of \$15/event or \$40 for all 3 events

**Late Cost** \$17 per event/\$45 for-3 for day-of registration.

**Onsite registration** will begin at 7:00 a.m. inside Endurance House. Registration closes 30 minutes before the estimated start time of each event. 1-day licenses will be available for \$10. *Please bring a photo ID to registration to go with your MyUSAC app.*

**Lodging:** Follow the SCCCC Google group for updates on lodging deals.

**Host Housing:** *We are attempting to find host housing.* If you are interested in taking advantage of this, please contact the promoter at [Zamastil@gmail.com](mailto:Zamastil@gmail.com) or call at (815) 762-5630 *before April 1* to have the best chance of securing a spot.

**TT Parking:** Please park at the Endurance House satellite shop. It is approximately 2 miles from the TT & Road Race starts, so please budget your time accordingly.

**RR Parking:** Please park at the Cameron Gardens Fire Department, 153 FM 1740. Please do not block the egress for the firetrucks.

**Crit parking:** Park in the easternmost parking lots of the Hardin Administration Building or the Moffett Library, between Taft Blvd and Council Drive.

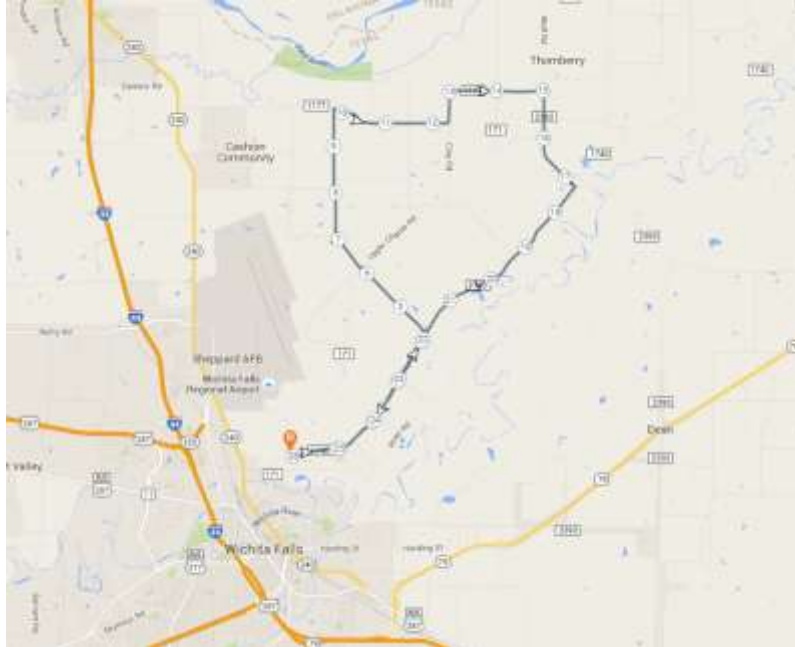
