Day of registration begins @ 9am both days. Register up to 15 minutes prior to each race start. Racers must have a USAC license or purchase a \$10.00 "one day license". One day license riders must race in the Cat 5 men or Women 5. Races begin rain or shine. USAC rules govern races. Riders must wear a USDOT or CPSC approved helmet anytime on a bike. No refunds. Organizer may combine fields of fewer than 6 riders. Protest period 15:00 after posting of results. Please review results prior to leaving. No changes after end of race day. *All start times are Central time.

Registration

- Preregistration at www.USACycling.org closes Friday, October 14th at 11pm

- Race day registration available on the day of the event beginning at 9:00 AM (Central time)
- You may register until 15 minutes before the start of each race.

Licenses

- All racers must present a valid racing license or authorization to ride form. Unlicensed riders will be required to purchase a \$10.00 oneday license or annual license, and will be placed in the Men's CX5 or Women's CX5 Categories. All riders will be required to complete and sign a standard athlete entry release form.

- OneDay(\$10), Annual USA Cycling(\$70) and junior(\$35) license sales available at registration.

Course

Course will consist of grass on flat to rolling terrain with a run up and barriers. Course distance will range between 1.55 and 2.5 miles. Course will be clearly marked with stakes and flagging throughout. Course will be at least 10 feet wide throughout to allow for easy maneuvering and passing. The course will feature an approximate 200 meter long start/ finish area that is approximately 6 meters wide. The course will have one pit.
